

2010 CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION

Constitutional Committee Role and Responsibilities

1. *The Constitutional Committee shall be made up of members of the AFSCME Local 1902 Standing Committee on By-laws and the Executive President*
2. *The Chairman of the Standing Committee on By-Laws shall be the Chairman of the Constitutional Committee, who's interpretation of the existing By-Laws or proposed Resolutions shall be final*
3. *The Constitutional Committee shall uphold and observe the highest ethical standards in the development of all proposed Resolutions and adjudication of the members' rights*
4. *The Constitutional Committee shall track, monitor and enforce the overall Convention Work Flow schedule, including all required submittals by delegates*
5. *The Committee shall create a Proposed Resolution Input Form to facilitate the orderly submission from members to delegates*
6. *The Committee shall validate eligibility and credential all delegates, staff and guests planning to attend the Convention*
7. *The Committee shall be timely in the production of the annotated Resolution Priority List, the 1st Draft Resolution Booklets, its Final Offer of Proposed Resolutions (including member petitions) to the Convention Floor, and convening and conducting meetings to consider delegate input*
8. *The Committee shall make final determination to accept or reject modifications to the proposed Resolutions duly offered by delegates prior to the Convention*
9. *The Committee shall keep records and track all changes resulting in modification to the proposed Resolutions on the Convention Floor*
10. *The Committee shall prepare and submit all proposed Amendment resulting from the ratification of Resolutions at the Convention for approval by the Local 1902 Executive Board, the AFSCME International President, and subsequently for ratification by the general membership of AFSCME Local 1902*
